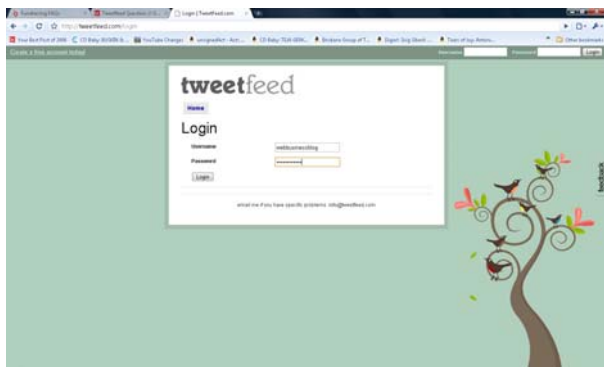


How to install the Tweetfeed Widget at a Hosted Wordpress Blog

Log into your Tweetfeed Account at <http://tweetfeed.com>



Select **Get Widgets**

Customize Your Widget

Search Terms

Widget width

Number of tweets to show

Set the value of the **Width of the Widget**

Note: the default is 250 pixels, you may need to edit this a little if you have a thin sidebar

Set the amount of Tweetfeeds to display

Note: the default is 5

Widget Code

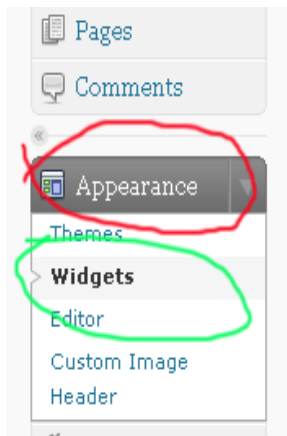
Copy & paste the following code into your blog or website:

src="http://tweetfeed.com/show
widget.php?
k=tweetfeed&l=5&w=250"></scrip

```

Click on **Update Widget Code** Button

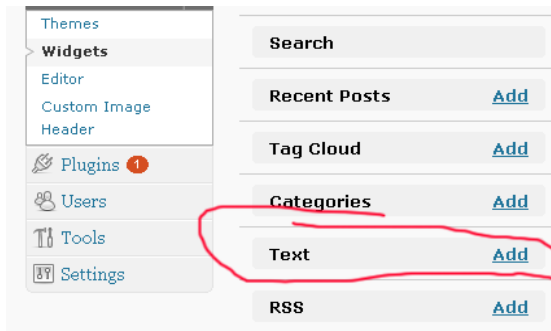
Click and drag in **the code box** from `<script` all the way to `</div>`

Login to your Wordpress Blog to Install the Widget



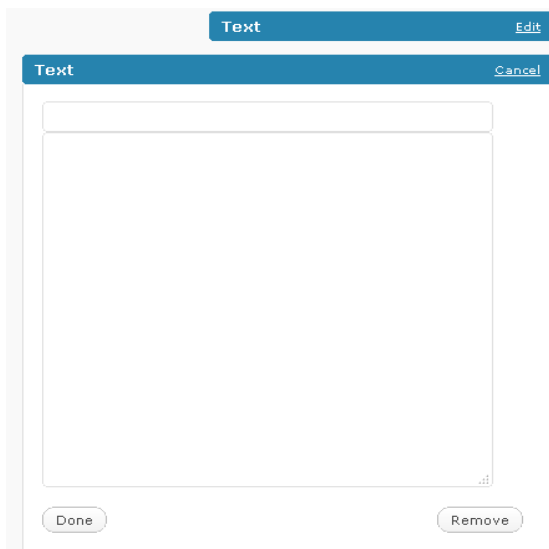
Select **Appearance** in the Left Menu

From the Dropdown Menu – **Select Widgets**



Click on Add next to **Text**

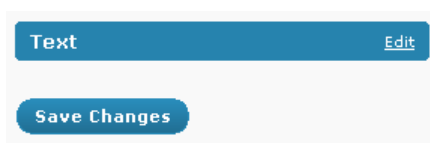
Note: This will place a new text widget (container to add text into)



Paste the Text from the Tweetfeed Widget into the text box

Click **Done**

Click **Save Changes**
